

Desi tells Latino jokes to the Miami Rotary Club and pitches his idea of a TV show called *Gilberto's Island*. Alejandro explains that he is a great macho who fights magnificent battles and also works as a busboy. In "Latinologues," issues of bi-ethnicity are lovingly illustrated, such as a special kind of tough love and the typecasting of a Hispanic actor who seems unaware that his roles could possibly be termed "minor." Latino plays have been rapidly making their mark in contemporary theater, and Rick Najera's work blends both the comic and serious sides of machismo.

In this debut collection, Najera proves himself to be one of the most exciting and talented Latino writers of his generation. Consisting of the title play, A Quiet Love, and Latinologues, which has been produced on Showtime's Latino Comedy Festival, the collection embodies self-deprecating humor, witty satire, and a deep empathy with the abuses and stereotypes Latinos have endured.
